STATEMENTS FOR HEARINGS Statements being submitted by participants in hearing sessions

Statements for hearings are subject to a 3,000 word limit (see the Guidance Note for the Examination) as evidence should have been submitted with representations made during the proposed submission consultation, as per procedural guidance.

The 3,000 word limit applies to the statement for the whole of a Matter, not for each section of a Matter. For example: Matter 6 is made up of sections 6A, 6B and 6C. One statement, with a limit of 3,000 words and focussing on responding to the Inspectors questions for that Matter where relevant, should be submitted for the whole of Matter 6 even if you are included as a participant in more than one section.

If separate statements are submitted for individual sections these will not be accepted and will be returned.
