
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Aim:

Key guiding principles:


- Priority to sustainable travel modes

What infrastructure is required?

"The SPD will make clear, for at least the first five years, what infrastructure is required, who is going to fund and provide it, and how it relates to anticipated rate and phasing of development...The longer term needs will be presented where information is available, although may be subject to change due to future economic, market or technological factors."



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Delivering the place

How will individual development parcels be coordinated?

Establishment of collaborative working groups involving SCDC, County Council, landowner representatives and relevant stakeholders will be secured through legal obligation imposed at outline planning application stage.


