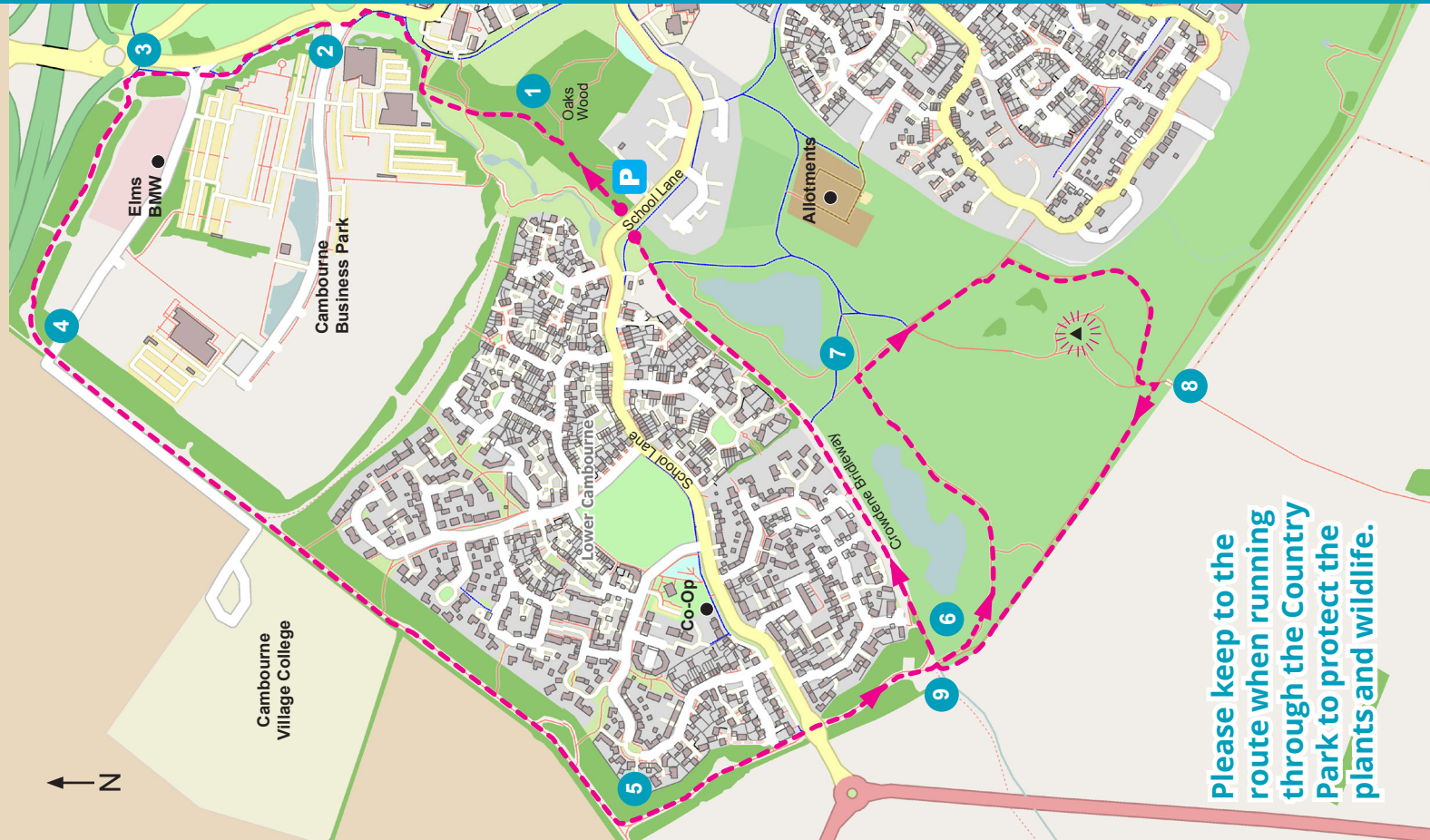


Cambourne Route 5Km



Please keep to the route when running through the Country Park to protect the plants and wildlife.

Start/Finish:

- 1 Parking is to the north of School Lane on the edge of the wood.
- 2 Turn right out of the gravelled car park and then right again, following the path through Oaks Wood. The path will eventually exit the wood, continue straight and skirt around the wood to the right. This will meet a red tarmaced path. Turn left and follow the path.
- 3 Continue north, crossing the entrance to the Business Park and then again, at Sheepfold Lane. Before you reach the roundabout, turn left down a grass track and through a gate and take the path.
- 4 Follow the path round to the left and cross the road to the college. Continue along the grassed footpath past the school gates keeping the college on the right.
- 5 You will come to a split in the path, follow this to the left (not through the hedge) and continue along until you come to a gate. Go through the gate, cross the road, then through a second gate and head down the cinder track beyond.
- 6 Further down, the track splits. Continue straight ahead past the hedgerow to your left and once passed, take the left of the two footpaths and follow it around the lake and across a small bridge.
- 7 The footpath then rejoins the main route. Turn right and up towards the hill and houses beyond. There will be a crossing of footpaths , continue straight, ignoring the route up the hill to the right. Follow the footpath keeping the houses to your left and the hill on your right.
- 8 This will join the main gravel track. Turn right and head down the hill.
- 9 At the bottom of the hill turn right again and follow the Crowdene bridleway with the bramble hedge and lakes to your right. It will join School Lane and if you glance across the road to the right, you will see the entrance to the car park.

Terrain:

Mixed terrain, including gates. Variable path widths, variable surfaces - may be muddy especially after rain and on footpaths shared with horse riders, the public and dog walkers.

Undulating, lots to see, great for beginners, obvious shortcuts if needed!

Free parking off of School Lane.

The route can be very muddy in the winter/early spring.
