I am looking for any contract where you are looking for a firm to provide security officers and related services in order to provide protection and/or management of any premises. The kind of contracts I am interested in will likely fall under one of these Common Procurement Vocabulary (CPV) codes:

79700000-1 Investigation and security services.

79710000-4 Security services.

79715000-9 Patrol services

79713000-5 Guard services

79992000-4 Reception services

79993000-1 Building and facilities management services

79993100-2 Facilities management services

Though please do not limit your answer to these codes only; any contracts which meet the criteria above but have different codes would still be of interest.

I would be grateful if you could supply the following information:

- A brief description of the nature of the contract (e.g., security at a secondary school or hospital).
- The estimated monetary value of the contract.
- The anticipated funding route/sources for the contract.
- The likely timeline for the commissioning and delivery of the contract.

I would also be grateful if you could please provide information on the security and facilities management (or related professional services) frameworks your authority currently participates in or has done in the last 2 years, how to apply to gain a position on these frameworks and what the time intervals are for gaining a position on the framework.
