

Request 9596 - Recently installed play equipment on Eltisley Green

As you will see from the attached photograph these recent additions to the play equipment have been installed far to the front of the original equipment. The main structure which is very large and placed close to a through road is most certainly out of keeping and blots the east view of the Green with it's Cade Cricket Pavilion which has long been the focal point of Eltisley's beautiful Green.

Eltisley Green and its surround is a conservation area and as a resident of the Green I know all to well the restrictions and requirements for even the smallest of proposed changes.
