Thank you for your request above and attachment.

We note the attachment is not an SCDC document and has not originated at the Council, this appears to be a summary created by Cambridgeshire Constabulary and can only recommend that you refer to the police officer who provided it to you. You can find out how to access material used in court matters on the [Information Commissioner's Officers \(ICO\) website](#).

In any event, any disclosure made under the Freedom of Information Act must be considered to be to the public at large, personal data of third parties (if held) will be exempt from disclosure under s40(2) of FOI , this is an absolute exemption and no further explanation is required.

We would add though, that as this relates to an ongoing police investigation that is yet to be finalised, if held, it would not be in the public interest to disclose any material that could prejudice any proceedings or indeed, if relevant, place any member of staff at risk.

We also note that you have already been provided with copies of all relevant correspondence held by the Council regarding your grant applications in your Subject Access Request – our ref 9324 – all officers you were in contact with regarding your applications to the Council will be known to you through your own correspondence with the department.
