Thank you for your request for information above, which we have dealt with under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I hope the following will answer your query:

1. Please send me a copy of the licence. **The redacted premises licence and licence summary are attached.**

2. What are the dates for the events next year? **As you will note on the licence, the licence is valid for 2 weekends Friday to Monday between 1 May and 30 September. The date for the Cambridge Club are 9-11 June 2023, it is expected that Strawberries and Creem would be the following weekend, however only 6 months' notice of the event date is required, so this has not yet been confirmed.**

3. In 2021 they took place in September not June. I note the licence is 'permanent'. **Yes, that is correct. Subject to the annual fee being paid, or the licence not being revoked/suspended etc.**

4. Is the licence for an indefinite period or is there an expiry date? **The licence is for an indefinite period, again as stated above, subject to payment of the annual fee.**

a. when is the licence due for renewal?

b. Will interested parties, so local residents such as myself, be able to make representations upon the application for renewal?

c. Will the application be advertised and if so where/when will the advert appear?

5. Was this event previously held at the polo club in Barton? **Yes**

If so:

a. why has the venue changed. **This was a decision of the organisers, not a request of the Council.**

b. How many noise complaints did scdc receive about the last event held by the organisers in Barton. **The festivals were last held at Haggis Farm in June 2019. There were 3 noise complaints about Strawberries & Creem and 1 about the Cambridge Club Festival**

6. How many noise nuisance complaints have you had this year about these events at Childerley? **4. These were all in relation to the Strawberries & Creem event. None were received about the Cambridge Club Festival.**

7. How much revenue did scdc receive from these 2 events this year? **The licence fee only. Waste was not collected by SCDC.**

8. How much does scdc expect to receive in terms of revenue from these events next year? **The Licence fee only.**

9. How much is the licence fee? **The annual fee is £4070, the initial application fee was £8100**
