#### **Qualifying Criteria**

In order to qualify to be considered for co-option onto the Housing Engagement Board as a tenant representative you must meet the following criteria (to be read in conjunction with the Qualification Criteria to become an Elected Tenant Representative document):

- You are a tenant or leaseholder of South Cambridgeshire District Council
- You are aged 18 years or over
- You do not work for South Cambridgeshire District Council Housing Service
- You are not related to a member of staff
- You do not have any rent or service charge arrears
- You are not subject to any tenancy issues as set out in Schedule 3 of the Housing Act (1985) and within Schedule 14 of the Localism Act (2011)
- You do not have a criminal record
