Willingham & Longstanton Medical Practice

- Two sites (patient choice)
- c.11,300 registered patients
- Cambridge Northern Villages PCN: (8 Practices, pts: c.50,250 Cottenham, Firs House, Maple Surgery, Milton Surgery, Over Surgery, Swavesey Surgery, Waterbeach Surgery and Willingham MP).
- Registered 2,750 patients from Northstowe to date
- Two-week turnaround for registering new patients.
- Enhanced Access: 44 hours per week (evenings and weekends) across PCN, delivered by Cambs GP Network. Nearest hub sites at Milton and Over should a FtF appointment be required.

Willingham & Longstanton Medical Practice

- Capacity to take a further c. 5,500 patients. Workforce and operational hours to increase, as necessary.
- Interim Community Space: location at Pathfinder Way, opposite the Green. Working with A R Urbanism and SCDC in the design and occupations of this space from Summer 2023 (to include assembly rooms, offices, food bank with café/kitchen facilities, NHS room).
- **NHS room:** in contract discussions to deliver mental health support, health visiting and midwifery services.
- Working on procurement and contracting options for newly commissioned permanent facility. Health and Wellbeing services to be co-located from both statutory and non-statutory services, working with System Partners from CUH, CPFT, CCS, LA, EEAST etc.



Willingham & Longstanton Medical Practice

- Plans to deliver a total of 1,740 sqm for a Civic Hub (1,300 GMS, Community Trusts 200, Pharmacy 120 and Dentistry 120).
- Patient/resident consultations
- Working to different timelines and costs of construction and how healthcare is delivered. PCNs and INs to collaborate.
- The Civic Hub needs to be flexible to accommodate both traditional healthcare and services that address the wider determinants of health (e.g., CAB, housing, social care, family hub, social prescribing, Public Health initiatives, social groups, leisure and active pursuits etc).
- More integration to deliver services closer to where people live (diagnostics, OPA, minor surgery, specialist treatments etc.).
- Workforce models to allow portfolio roles between Trusts, LA and PC.
