Thank you for resubmitting the report (JW) for South Cambridgeshire Community Safety Partnership to the Home Office Quality Assurance (QA) Panel. The report was reassessed in July 2023.

The QA Panel felt the report feels open and reflects the contents of the IMRs. There is appropriate panel membership, including representation from the local Women's Aid and Age UK. The panel were clearly engaged as evidenced by the number of panel meetings and the report provides some sense of JW as a person.

There is some good learning and recommendations drawn out from the report, including to explore what can be done when vulnerable adults do not take up social care support, the use of carer's assessments as well as learning around the importance of safeguarding and multi-agency meetings when supporting adults at risk.

The Home Office noted that most of the issues raised in the previous feedback letter following the first submission have now been addressed.

The view of the Home Office is that the DHR may now be published.
