- Government urged UK universities to forge closer links with new high-tech industries

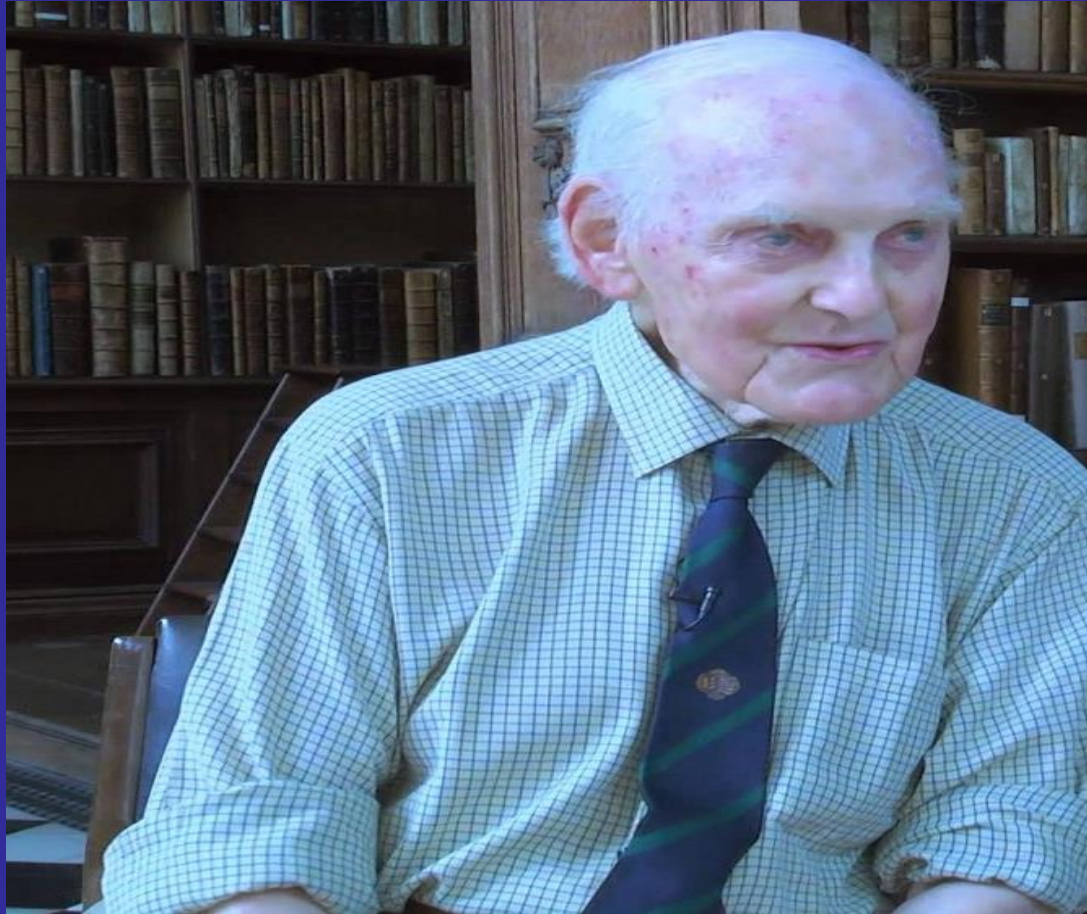
Sir Neville Mott

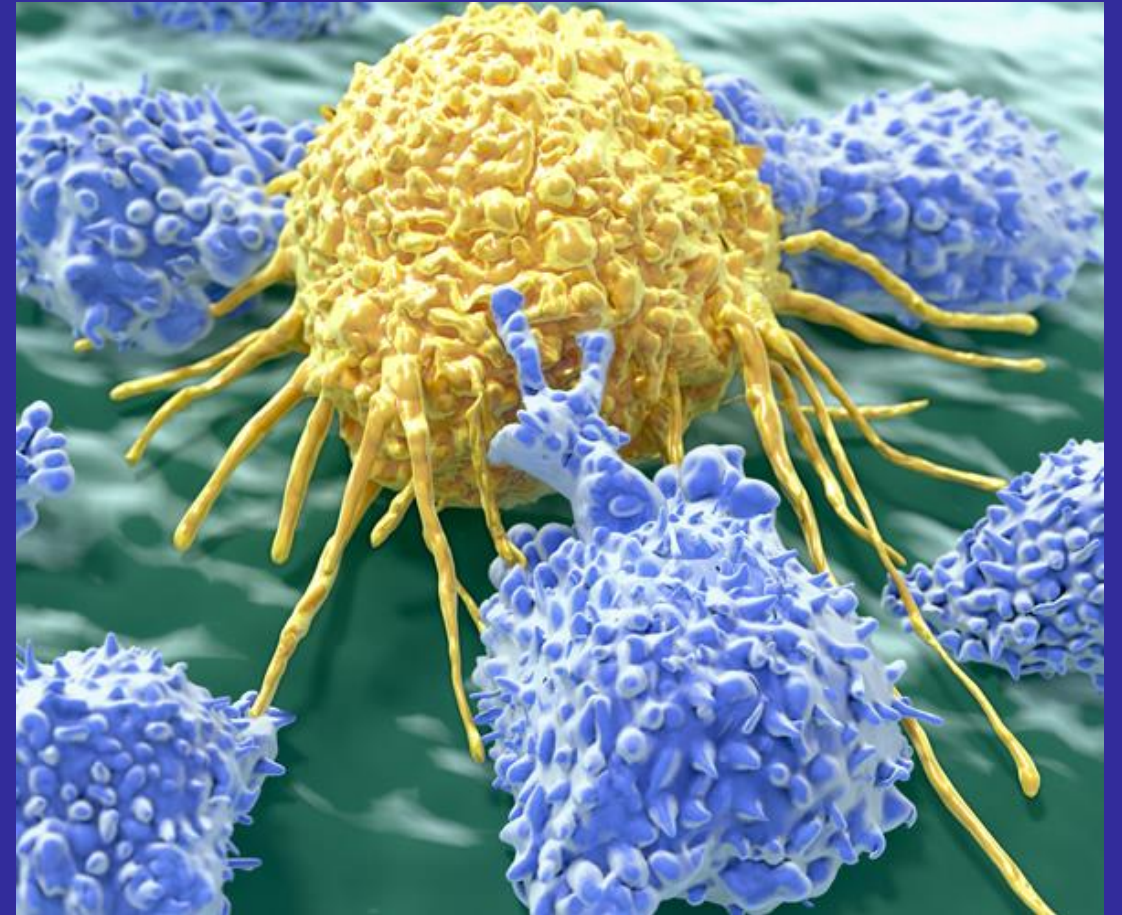

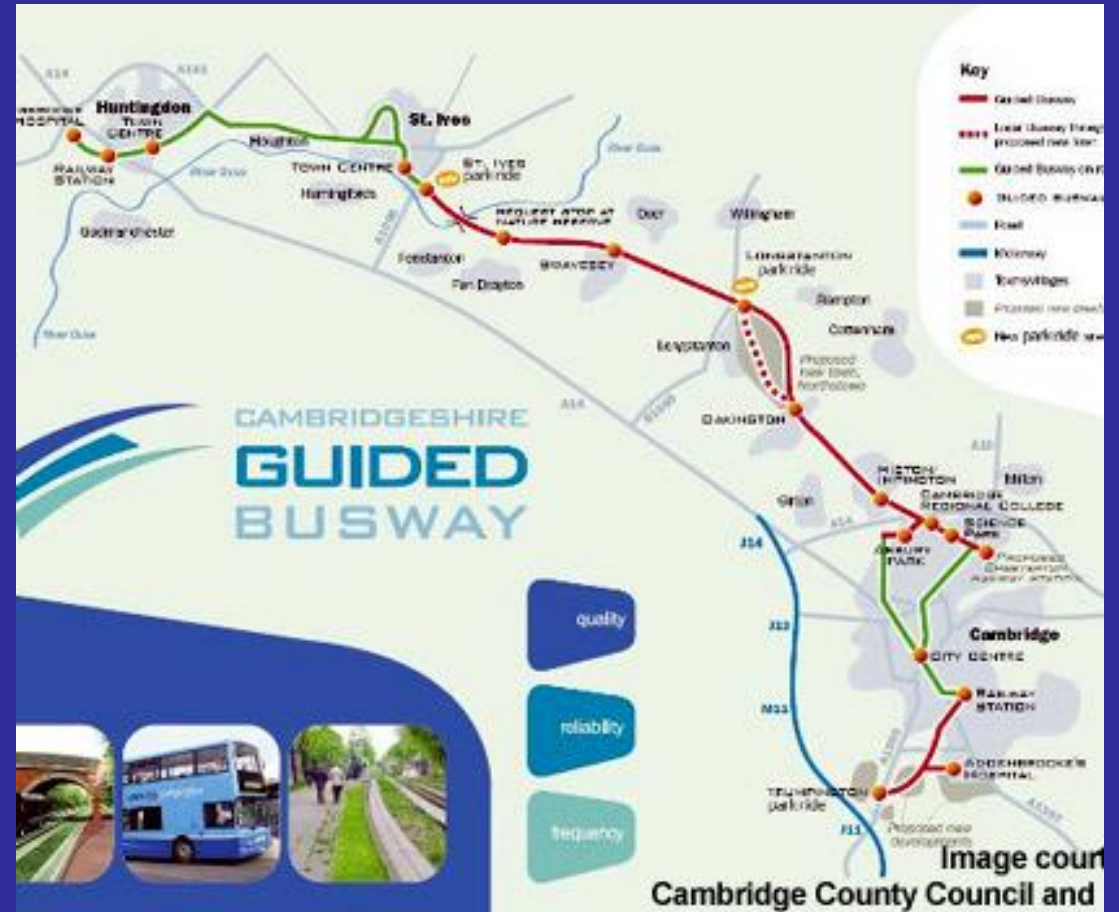

VIX Technology

- Advanced RTPI on each stop on the busway
- Vehicles are tracked via satellite
- Location details sent to a central back office server; used to calculate next arrival
- Information displayed to passengers at stops, including delays in service
- Also communicated to passengers on a range of media including web and mobile devices

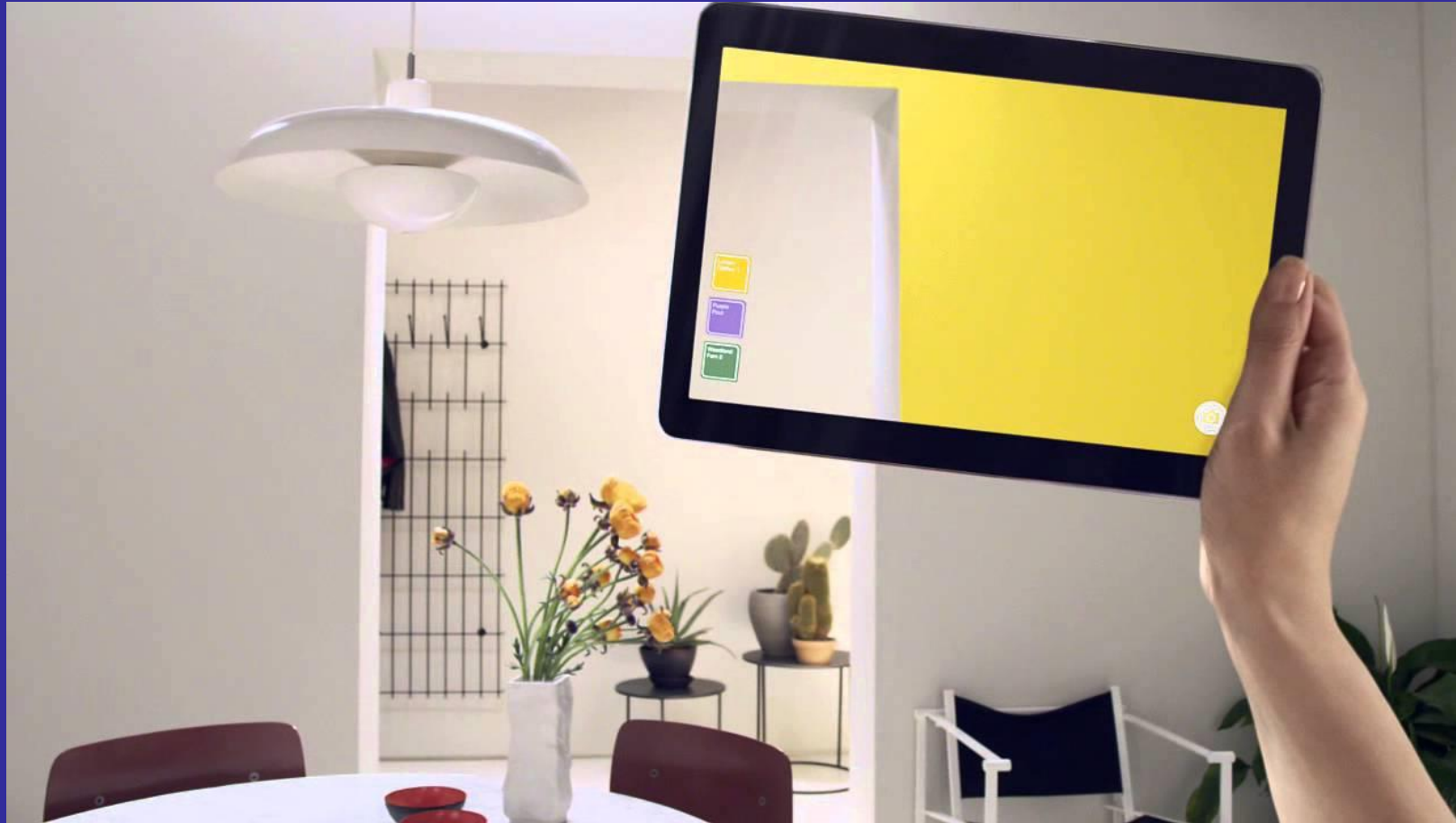

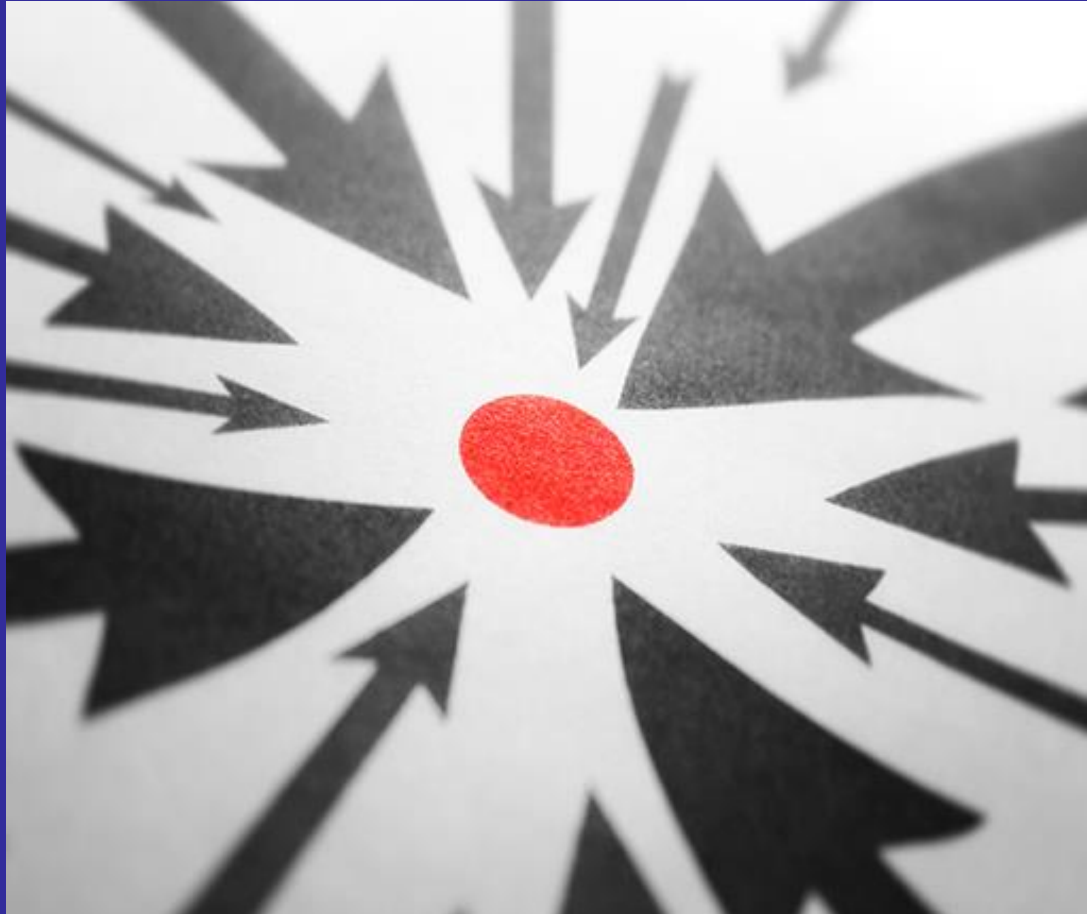

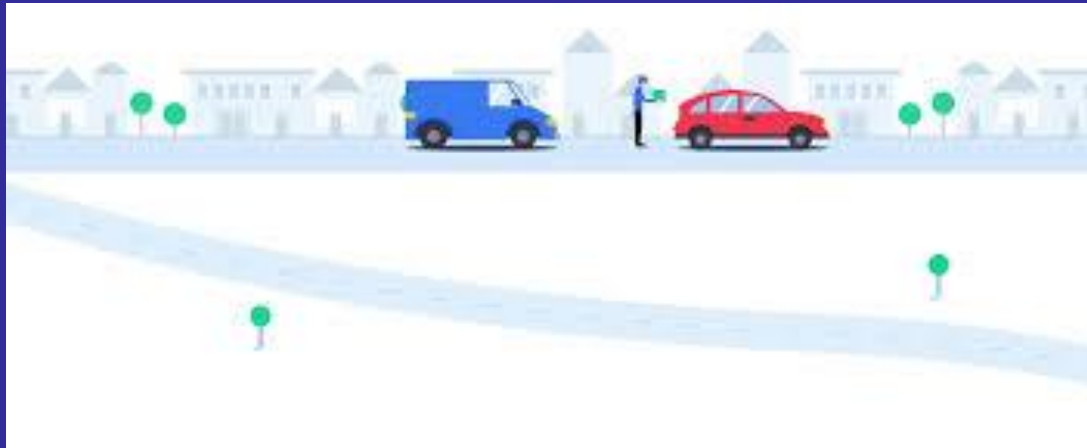
