I write to inform you that during recent turning Treatment Bed TB100 exhibited a yellow colouration something, which we have previously encountered where DNOC material has previously been identified on site. TB100 originated from grid squares J13, K12 and K13 where CNPI were previously identified and were notified to the Authority at the time. For the sake of prudency, our site team scheduled a further full VOC and SVOC screen of the material which identified two further CNPI which have a similar chemical structure to two of the Contaminants of Concern (CoC) and which were not identified at the time of excavation.

While we have already undertaken the grid square sampling and reported the CNPI identified relating to grid squares J13, K12 and K13, we will treat this as a further separate CNPI report under the same procedure and will seek to submit this for approval by the Authority within the next 28 days.
