Action

- 1. PK discussed Northstowe Phase 2 development plan including size and key proposals. A submission date in July 2014 is intended with an aim to attain planning permission in late 2015. Infrastructure construction to commence in 2017/18.
- 2. AT discussed archaeological work already done noting that the approach to evaluation had been constrained by land access and UXO issues. AT confident that most of the ditched/enclosed sites had been identified although there is scope for hitherto unidentified sites to be present. Archaeological works in connection with Phase 2 construction can be expected in 2016. Identified sites should be dealt with as single entities the case of Site XIX which straddles Phase 1 and Phase 2 areas was noted. There is a need to give confidence to the predictions made based on evaluation in which context AT noted the developer of the Phase 1 area had agreed a scheme to strip, map and record the Phase 1 site infrastructure in order to test the validity of the evaluation results.
- 3. AT noted that CHET would not be averse to revisiting the evaluation and undertaking further evaluation work however, CHET has sufficient information to assess any mitigation strategy for Phase 2 and would not require any further works to be undertaken.
- **4.** AT indicated that the mitigation strategy for Northstowe Phase 2 should include provision for a spectrum of intervention including

excavation, strip/map/assess and a contingency for encountering hitherto unlocated sites. Protection measure should be incorporated into any Construction Method Statement or Code of Construction Practice.

- 5. AT indicated that relevant background material should be included as Appendices to the ES. This material could include an Historic Environment Management Plan.
- **6.** PK noted that the possibility of splitting archaeological costs across construction phasing was useful.
- Responses to the Scoping report were discussed. DL noted English Heritage concerns regarding the proposed assessment methodology. AT noted that the principle of development was established and that a matrix approach was anticipated. AT noted the Phase 1/Phase 2 interface as exemplified by Site XIX stressing the need for continuity of approach.
- **8.** The status of the 2007 Archaeology and Built Heritage Strategy was discussed. It was noted that the Strategy was not adopted. AT indicated that a piecemeal approach would not work.
- 9. Built Heritage English Heritage to advise on listed structures and AT on non-listed although AT indicated that he would defer to a colleague as this was not his area of expertise. PK discussed background to listing of Oakington pillboxes and retention of buildings on Phase 2.
- AT indicated that CHET were keen to work with HCA in promoting the way in which the historic environment could help develop a sense of place for the new community. Areas for community digs would be supported and encouraged. Building info packs could include historic environment detail. PK discussed the possibility of a heritage centre emphasising the need to set up a trust and the need to avoid overreach. AT suggested that a heritage centre could curate elements of any excavation archive generated by work on the site and mount semi-
