BUILDINGS OF INTEREST IN HISTON AND IMPINGTON, NOVEMBER 2017

We are very fortunate that our two villages, with a combined population of around 8,000, have such a fine portfolio of lovely buildings of character and interest. A list of these was expertly put together by our Village Archivist, Eleanor Whitehead, in 2012.

Now we have been asked to submit a list of buildings with special local interest as part of the Heritage Section of the forthcoming Neighbourhood Plan.

A number of our buildings are already officially Listed and they do not form part of this report.

We have considered lots of other village buildings, etc., and have identified a limited number which we feel fall into the following categories:

- 1. Those which need to be Listed anyway
- 2. Those in Histon, which are of special local interest
- 3. Those in Impington, which are also of special local interest

In categories 2 and 3, there are some, which upon further investigation, could well deserve due recognition and merit Listing.

This basic report is to support the Histon and Impington Parish Council's forthcoming Neighbourhood Plan in 2018 and has been prepared at short notice with limited resources by a few members of the Histon and Impington Village Society. In particular, our grateful thanks must go to Alan Eade, who has given up a lot of his time to share his specialist knowledge of buildings, both old and new.
