Summary

The village has one recreation ground that has a pavilion, football pitch, bowls green and two tennis courts that are used by local clubs.

There is one football club within the village and a bowls club but no formal junior provision.

The Bowls Club is looking to expand the pavilion to ensure that full County games can be hosted at Duxford – the current facility is too small at present.

The refurbishment of the play area was carried out in 2011 and the total cost was £100000 with £25000 contribution from South Cambs.
