Summary

The village has one recreation ground with two senior football pitches, a number of mini soccer pitches, a cricket square, bowls green, three hard tennis courts (2 floodlit) and a play area.

In addition there are 2 football pitches at the hospital site but these are not generally available to the public, these are currently part of a development plan on which the Parish Council would like to see the development of junior and mini pitches.

Fulbourn Tennis Club has developed and continues to grow. There are a large number of football teams that play in the village including a thriving youth and mini section. The cricket club has three adult teams and 3 youth sides.

The Parish Council has provided an artificial floodlit training pitch for casual use, local football club training and would like to provide an indoor sports centre. They are also considering an extra football pitch, tennis court and 'youth facilities'.

Fulbourn Parish Council has provided outdoor adult gym equipment in 2011 and were awarded £2300 towards total project cost of £7862.

In 2009 additional pieces of equipment for the established skate park were acquired at a cost of \pounds 9450
