Summary

The village has no formal outdoor sports provision or sports clubs in the village; however the Parish Plan has identified the need to increase opportunities for outdoor leisure and sports for residents. It also suggests investigate possibilities for shared use of grounds in Coton & Barton and publicise sports & outdoor leisure opportunities available there.
